Colour: Deep russet.

Nose: Notes of rich oak, dried fruit, figs, raisins and sultanas, balanced with treacle toffee, dark chocolate, and vanilla.

Palate: Rich oakiness balanced with sweet dried fruit, treacle toffee, black coffee and cocoa, and roasted nuts,

with a hint of coastal brininess.

Finish: Dry but lingering sweet fruit and oak.
