



DOMAINE COLLOTTE MARSANNAY BLANC

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Four generations of the Collotte family have lived and grown vines in Marsannay-la-Côte, the most northerly village of the Côte de Nuits. In 1981, Philippe Collotte - aged only 16 - was the first to bottle his wines under the family name. Today, his talented daughter Isabelle runs this 17-hectare domaine, having finished her studies at the prestigious wine school of Beaune. Marsannay has a reputation for producing beautiful, generous and well-priced Pinot Noir and is the only Burgundy appellation that can also release white and rosé. Locally, Domaine Collotte is regarded as a winery to watch.

The grapes come from three parcels of vines aged between 20 and 30 years: Les Etalles, En Blungray and Le Poiset, all planted on limestone soil. After a gentle press, the juice is fermented in 50% French oak barrels for 9 months—the rest in tanks to offer some freshness.
