Ideally located at the gateway to the Saint-Estèphe appellation, Château Cos Labory takes its name from the "caux" meaning hill of pebbles coupled with that of its 1820-1840 owner, François Labory. Classified as Fifth Grand Cru Classé in the famous 1855 classification. Passing through the hands of various owners, it was finally acquired by the Audoy family in 1971, and has now been bought by Michel Reybier, owner of Cos D'Estournel

The Château Cos Labory is based on 18 hectares of vines, 58% of which are Cabernet Sauvignon, 36% Merlot and 6% Petit Verdot. The wines are aged for 14 months in French oak barrels, 50% of which are new
