Château Bruni is a 66 hectare estate located in Blasimon, to the South of St Emilion. Coming from a long family of winegrowers, Bruno Cazautets represents the fifth generation at the head of Château Bruni. His grandfather was one of the founders of the Cave de Sauveterre. The estate has been working sustainably since 2005, with minimal environmental impact.

Their delicious rosé is a blend of 80% Cabernet Franc and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, made in a modern style with a delicately pale pink colour, vinified in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks to preserve freshness and aroma.

This crisp, dry rosé offers up floral aromas of wild strawberry, rosehip and thyme. Light and fresh with a restrained, elegant palate, this is perfect alone or with salads and simply grilled fish.
