



CHÂTEAU MAZARIN PREMIERES CÔTES DE BORDEAUX BLANC (SWEET)

Located in the commune of Gabarnac, the estate belongs to the Arnaud family. They have 20 hectares of vineyards, primarily in Loupiac, and 3 hectares in Premières Côtes de Bordeaux. The soil is mostly Clay-limestone with a little sand. The blend of grapes for this wine is 90% Sémillon and 10% Muscadelle, harvested late and by hand in successive passes when the grapes are high in sugar. Pressing is followed by fermentation in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks to preserve the freshness and purity of the wines. This is a late harvest sweet wine of great purity and clarity with a floral nose of honeysuckle, ripe pineapple and candied lemon. A concentrated yet balanced palate, a fine thread of tangy citrus which balances the sweetness of the wine.

Perfect with fresh fruit-based desserts and cheese.
